

Lincoln County Fair Royalty Rules and Guidelines

The purpose of the Fair Royalty program is to promote the Lincoln County Fair events and greet visitors and assist with day to day activities.

LINCOLN COUNTY ROYALTY CONTESTANT RULES:

- 1) Contestants must meet 1 of the below 3 criteria:
 - a. Be a resident of Lincoln County
 - b. Attend a school in Lincoln County
 - c. Be a member of an FFA, 4-H Club, or organized youth group within Lincoln County.
- 2) Be a female or male at least 15 but not over 20 years of age by December 1, 2010.
- 3) Have her parent or guardian's consent if under age 18.
- 4) Candidates must be single and never have been married, divorced or had a marriage annulled. It must be understood, also, that contestants entering the pageant shall never have been pregnant.
- 5) Attend a MANDATORY orientation meeting in April of 2010 (Date TBD).
- 6) Be available during the Lincoln County Fair July 14-18, 2010.
- 7) Contests must follow general appearance and attire guidelines outlined by the Fair Royalty Committee.

Royalty Responsibilities prior to and during the fair:

- Promote Friday/Saturday Bull Ride event through advance ticket sales and promotional events. Minimum 50 adult tickets.
- Meet and greet visitors and local officials answering questions about the fair.
- Deliver fair signage and brochures to local merchants.
- Attend all Grandstand events and assist as needed
- Give welcome greeting at all Grandstand events
- Give welcome greeting at Sunday morning Polka Service
- Be host for the Fairest of the Fair (if they visit)
- Assist in setup of Thursday morning Judge's breakfast and attend to meet and greet judges.
- Give introduction at as many judging events as possible, even if not at beginning of judging – stop by and introduce themselves to the crowd and exhibitors.
- Do community events
 - o June Dairy Breakfast
 - o Merrill/Tomahawk/Wausau Parades
- Announcements/Assistance in the Fair Office

Each contestant and their parents must sign a form stating they are responsible for all advance tickets they request and if any are not returned the contestant and/or parents are responsible for the reimbursement of the tickets at their full value.

Shirts and/or sashes awarded to all participants.

Awards: Minimum award of \$50 will be given to each participant if they complete the sale of 50 adult bullride tickets. For each ticket sold over 50 by the participant, they will receive an additional \$1.

100 tickets sold = \$100

500 tickets sold = \$500

1000 tickets sold = \$1000
